Otolaryngology Diversity Residency Applicant Travel Grant Program

Program Description

The Otolaryngology Diversity Residency Applicant Travel Grant Program is designed to encourage medical students from diverse backgrounds to meet our residents and faculty and consider the exceptional training that the University of Washington Department of Otolaryngology-HNS has to offer. Qualified residency applicants in the current Otolaryngology MATCH who are invited to interview for a residency position are eligible to receive up to \$500 of funding to offset qualified travel expenses for the interview process.

Who Should Apply

The program is open to invited applicants who belong to groups that are recognized as historically underrepresented in the health and science professions including: *Black/African American, Native American, Alaska Native, Latino/Hispanic, Filipino, Hmong or Pacific Islander*.
